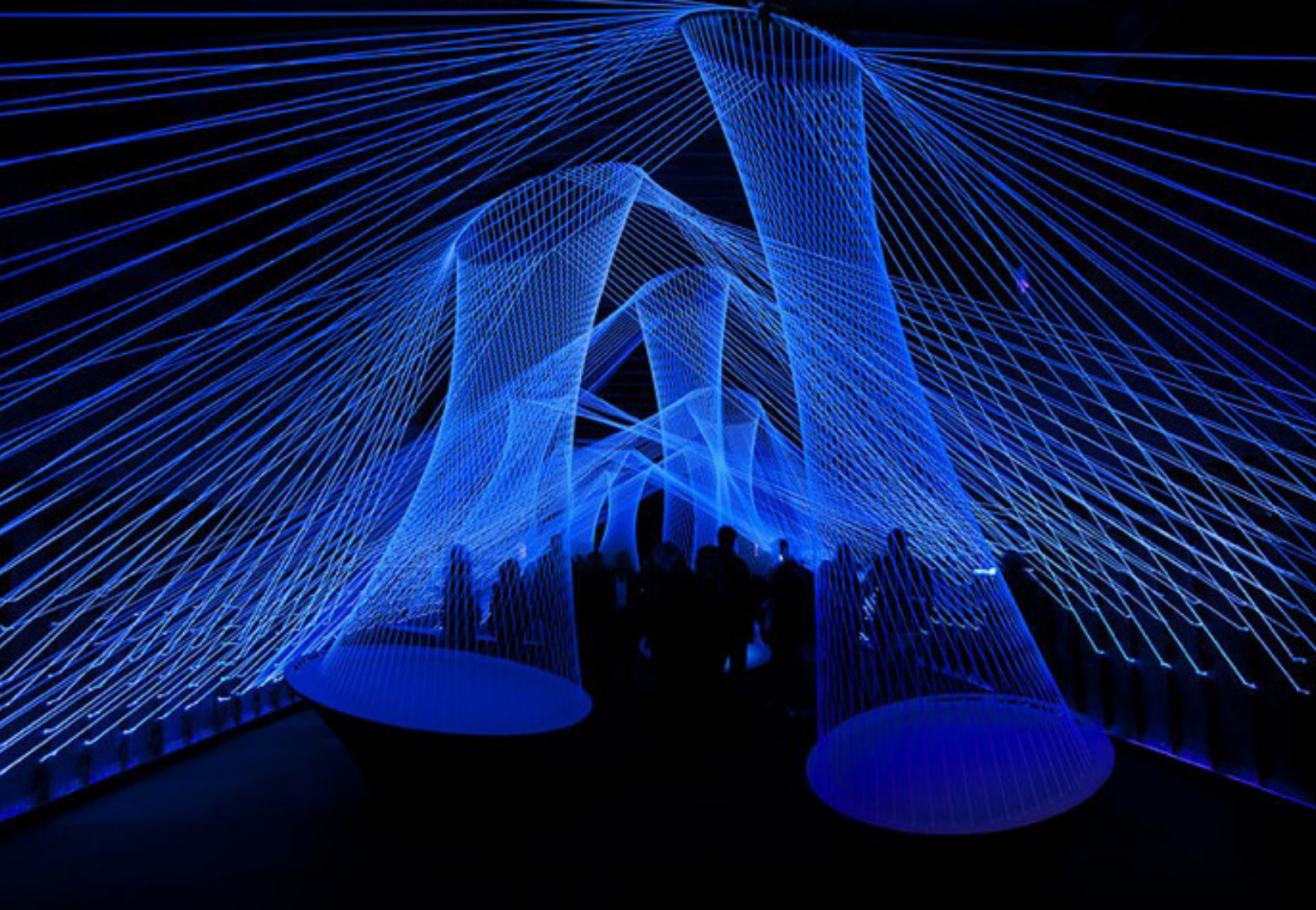




Art lighting using robotics as entertainment for passersby.

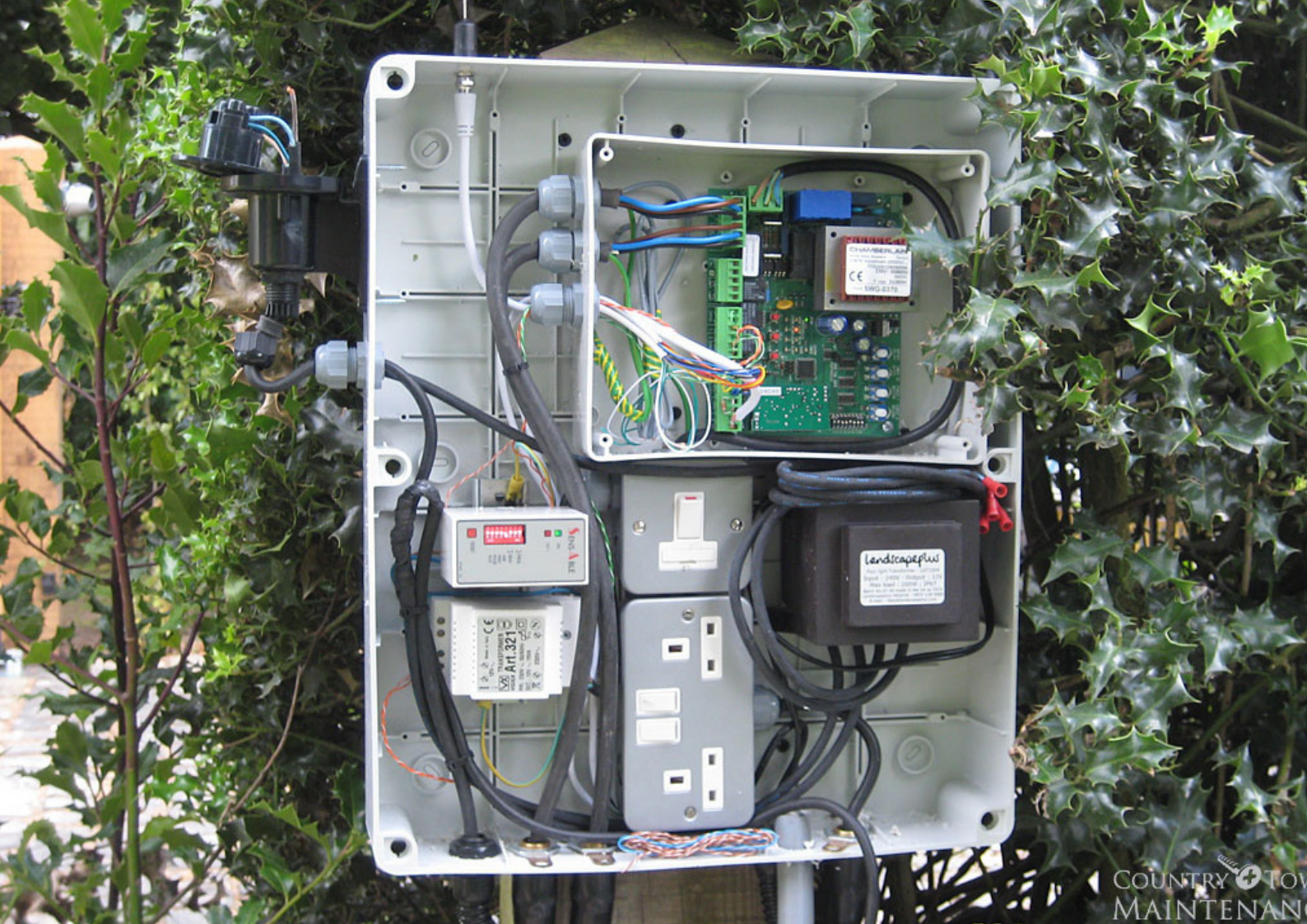
